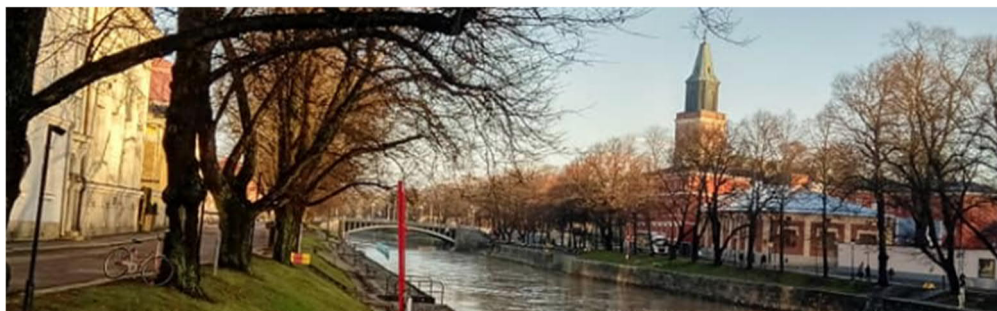
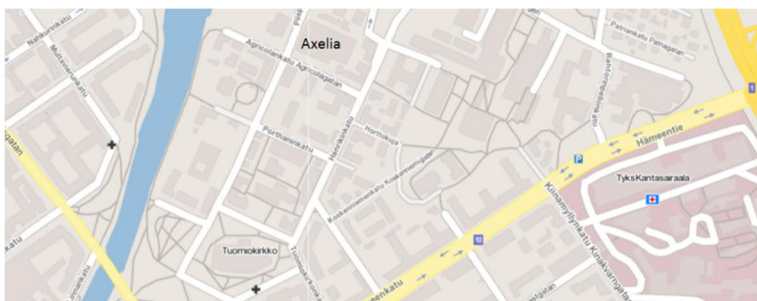


Invitation to the 5th FINMARI Researcher Day 10th of March 2020
